A collaborative 20-person research project focused on finding solutions to voter accessibility problems in American elections. Produced in partnership with global digital transformation \_ \_ J consultancy Kin + Carta. Final deliverable included a presentation

deck and an expansive case study going over our research and design processes, as well as an interactive Figma prototype of final design solution.

On this project, I worked as a UX Design and Research Team Lead. Throughout the project, I led research on voter pain point and target audience analysis to ensure our solution had the largest possible impact. Following that, I led a research team on studying tone and humor to determine the best language to use to reach our new audience. ## Chicago Resource Project

THICAGO A collaborative 7-person research project focused on highlighting the history of police brutality by the Chicago Police Department and activism efforts against police brutality incidences. This history was collected into a modular interactive timeline for users to scroll
